

CAPE SMOKEY PROVINCIAL PARK

Located on the Cabot Trail, 13 kilometres (8 miles) south of Ingonish Beach, Cape Smokey Provincial Park offers dramatic coastal views. A 10 kilometre (6 mile) return trail offers numerous look-offs along 275 metre (900 foot) granite cliffs. Bald eagles and a variety of hawk species can often be viewed soaring on the updrafts along the cliff line. The hike takes approximately four hours return.

Picnic facilities are provided at the start of the trail.

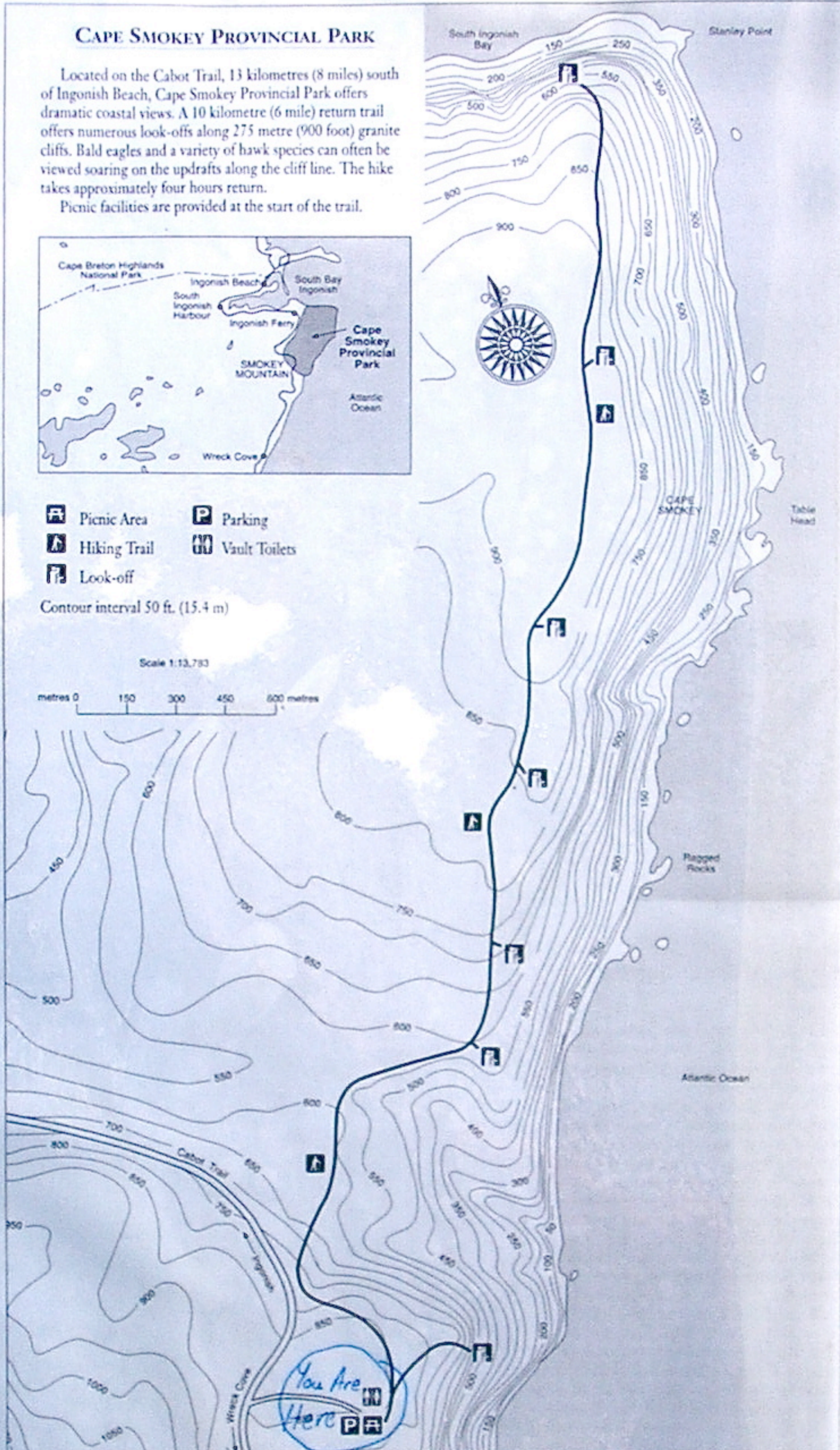

- Comfortable hiking boots or other sturdy footwear should be worn on the trails.
- Please keep pets on a leash at all times.
